



**Bryan Memorial Gallery
GEMS AND GIANTS
November 11 to December 19, 2021**

- SUBJECT:** Bryan Memorial Gallery's annual members' GEMS & GIANTS exhibit returns this year to the gallery's Main Gallery and Middle Room. Members are invited to submit works to either the GEMS exhibit or GIANTS exhibit, or may submit to both exhibits.
- ELIGIBILITY:** **GEMS:** All artists are invited to submit a maximum of **three works** of art for GEMS, and **are guaranteed entrance** of these submitted works. **GIANTS:** All artists are invited to submit a maximum of three works of art for GIANTS. **Due to limited space, all works submitted for GIANTS will be juried.** **All works must not have been previously shown at Bryan Memorial Gallery or in Lamoille County, VT.** You are required to become a member of Bryan Memorial Gallery to have your work exhibited in either GEMS or GIANTS. If you have been a recent member of Bryan Memorial Gallery, but your membership is not current, or if you have not been a member previously, a Membership form can be found on the gallery's website: <http://www.bryangallery.org/membership.php>. **All works must be available for sale.**
- SPECIFICATIONS:** Only original works conceived and created by the entrant, will be considered. **Works submitted to GIANTS must be a minimum of 36" or larger for one side of the image. Image sizes for GEMS must not exceed 8"x 10" unframed, and outside frame dimensions must not exceed 14"x 16".** Artwork must be suitably framed, with hanging cable installed on the backs of the paintings. Sawtooth or clip hangers are not allowed. Unframed, "gallery wrapped" canvases, with the edges painted, are acceptable.

HOW TO SUBMIT: Artists may submit a **maximum of three works for GEMS** as well as a **maximum of three works for GIANTS**. All GEMS and GIANTS' entries must be presented through the gallery's online submissions process www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin . All GEMS are guaranteed entry, and submitting online allows us to display them on the website and gives us the necessary information for tags. Submissions for GIANTS will be juried. If you are not a current member of Bryan Memorial Gallery contact the gallery to submit your email address in order that you can access the on line submission form, or email the gallery: info@bryangallery.org . The gallery's response time is usually swift, but please allow a day before your information is in the system.

SCHEDULE:

Friday, Sept 3: Online submissions open on or before this date.

Sunday, Sept 26: Online submission to this exhibition must be received at www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin/ on or before this date.

Sunday, Oct 3: Artists will be informed of the jurors' decision regarding what GIANTS works will and will not be included in this exhibition.

Sunday, Oct 31: All works for this show must be shipped or delivered to Bryan Memorial Gallery.

Thursday, Nov 11: Exhibition opens to the public

Sunday, Nov 14: Artist Roundtable and Reception.

Sunday, Dec 19: Last day of exhibition

Pick up artwork today or during this week through Thursday, Dec 23.

Artists outside the local area should make arrangements with the gallery for the return shipping of their artwork at the artist's expense.

NOTE: Work left at the gallery for more than 180 days after the end date of the show will be considered abandoned. The gallery will make every effort to inform you of the pending pickup deadline, however the gallery reserves the right to dispose of unclaimed work after 180 days through the best means possible. This may include auctioning the work for the benefit of the gallery.

JURY PROCESS: A team of seasoned jurors will review each artist's entries and select the works to be included in the GIANTS segment of GEMS AND GIANTS. The jury's decision will be conclusive and final. Following the jury, you will be contacted by email informing you of the jury's decision.

- TAGS:** Artists must attach TAGS to the back of the accepted works with their **NAME, TITLE OF WORK, IMAGE DIMENSIONS (height x width: excluding mat and frame.), MEDIUM AND PRICE.** Tags are available at the gallery's website: <http://bryangallery.org/pdfs/ArtworkTags.pdf>. **Please have your work labeled in advance of bringing it into the gallery.**
- RECEIPT FORM:** The titles and prices listed on your submission to the jury must not be changed after the work has been juried, so please title and price your work carefully on the application. No substitutions will be accepted. When delivering or shipping your work, please include a completed receipt form. The form can be found on the gallery's website at <http://www.bryangallery.org/pdfs/PaintingReceiptForm.pdf>.
- DELIVERY:** Works must be received at the gallery on or before **October 29, 2021.** Works can be delivered in person or shipped to the gallery (at the artist's expense).
- INSURANCE:** Each artist understands and agrees Bryan Gallery does not assume responsibility for loss or damage for either jurying materials or artwork. All risks of loss or damage at the gallery or in transit will be borne by the artist. While every precaution is made to safeguard entries, work is submitted at the artist's risk.
- SALES AND COMMISSIONS:** If your work is juried into this exhibition and is sold during the exhibition, the gallery's commission will be 50% of the retail price you have designated or later approved before sale.
- EXHIBITION DATES:** Accepted artists must agree to leave their works at Bryan Memorial Gallery for the duration of the exhibition. No exceptions.
- UNSOLD PIECES:** After the exhibition, any unsold works will be returned to the artist. The artist may pick up their pieces in person at the gallery, or the gallery will ship the works at your request at your own expense, in the packing materials provided when shipped to the gallery. Please note the dates for pick up as the gallery is limited in storage space.
