



**Bryan Memorial Gallery
MAIN STREET
A Juried Theme Exhibition
May 6 – June 20, 2021**

- SUBJECT:** Works in all two-dimensional media, featuring subject matter of New England city and town main streets will be shown in the gallery's Middle Room. The jury will be looking for works in which the artist represents the diversity of New England's Main Street landscapes and streetscapes, ranging from Boston Common to Main Street, Jeffersonville, as long as the work depicts a main thoroughfare and its local architecture.
- ELIGIBILITY:** All artists are invited to submit a maximum of **three works** of art for this show, **not previously shown at Bryan Memorial Gallery or in Lamoille County, VT.** If your work is accepted into the exhibit, you are required to become a member of Bryan Memorial Gallery to have your work exhibited in MAIN STREET. If you have been a recent member of Bryan Memorial Gallery, but your membership is not current, or if you have not been a member previously, a Membership form can be found on the gallery's website: <http://www.bryangallery.org/membership.php>. **All works must be available for sale.**
- SPECIFICATIONS:** Only original works conceived and created by the entrant, will be considered. There are no size limitations on works of art. Artwork must be suitably framed, with hanging cable installed on the backs of the paintings. Sawtooth or clip hangers are not allowed. Unframed, "gallery wrapped" canvases, with the edges painted, are acceptable.
- HOW TO SUBMIT:** Artists may submit a maximum of three two-dimensional works of art for this show. All entries must be presented through the gallery's online submissions process www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin . If you are not a current member of Bryan Memorial Gallery, contact the gallery to submit your email address in order that you can access the online submission

form, or email the gallery: info@bryangallery.org . The gallery's response time is usually swift, but please allow a day before your information is in the system.

SCHEDULE:

Friday, March 12: Online submissions open on or before this date.

Sunday, March 28: Online submission to this exhibition must be received at www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin/ on or before this date.

Sunday, April 11: Artists will be informed of the jurors' decision regarding what works will and will not be included in this exhibition.

Monday, April 26: All works for this show must be shipped or delivered to Bryan Memorial Gallery.

Thursday, May 6: Exhibition opens to the public

Sunday, May 9: Artist Roundtable and Reception

Sunday, June 20: Last day of exhibition

Pick up artwork today or during this week through Friday, June 25.

Artists outside the local area should make arrangements with the gallery for the return shipping of their artwork at the artist's expense.

JURY PROCESS:

A team of seasoned jurors will review each artist's entries and select the works to be included in the MAIN STREET exhibition. The jury's decision will be conclusive and final. Following the jury, you will be contacted by email informing you of the jury's decision.

TAGS:

Artists must attach TAGS to the back of the accepted works with their **NAME, TITLE OF WORK, IMAGE DIMENSIONS (height x width: excluding mat and frame.), MEDIUM AND PRICE.** Tags are available at the gallery's website: <http://bryangallery.org/pdfs/ArtworkTags.pdf>. **Please have your work labeled in advance of bringing it into the gallery.**

RECEIPT FORM:

The titles and prices listed on your submission to the jury must not be changed after the work has been juried, so please title and price your work carefully on the application. No substitutions will be accepted. When delivering or shipping your work, please include a completed receipt form. The form can be found on the gallery's website at <http://www.bryangallery.org/pdfs/PaintingReceiptForm.pdf>.

DELIVERY: Each artist whose work is juried into this exhibition will be notified as to which pieces to deliver to the gallery. Works must be received at the gallery on or before **April 26, 2021**. Works can be delivered in person or shipped to the gallery (at the artist's expense).

INSURANCE: Each artist understands and agrees Bryan Gallery does not assume responsibility for loss or damage for either jurying materials or artwork. All risks of loss or damage at the gallery or in transit will be borne by the artist. While every precaution is made to safeguard entries, work is submitted at the artist's risk.

SALES AND COMMISSIONS:

If your work is juried into this exhibition and is sold during the exhibition, the gallery's commission will be 50% of the retail price you have designated or later approved before sale.

EXHIBITION DATES: Accepted artists must agree to leave their works at Bryan Memorial Gallery for the duration of the exhibition. No exceptions.

UNSOLD PIECES: After the exhibition, any unsold works will be returned to the artist. The artist may pick up their pieces in person at the gallery, or the gallery will ship the works at your request at your own expense, in the packing materials provided when shipped to the gallery. Please note the dates for pick up as the gallery is limited in storage space.
