

Bryan Memorial Gallery 2024 Small Members Group Show March 6 to May 12, 2024

SUBJECT:

Bryan Memorial Gallery is excited to offer artists a unique opportunity to partake in a small collaborative group members show to be displayed in the East Gallery from March 6– May 12.

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists who wish to participate will be required to register and purchase one or more spaces to display a select number of their works in the East Gallery. Each space is approximately 10' x 8' in dimension. If you wish to purchase a space, they are available through the Gallery for \$200; with your purchase you will receive:

- Exhibition of a small collection of your work in a high quality, high visibility gallery venue.
- A reduced Gallery commission, as in the Gallery will only retain 30% of the sale and the artist will receive 70% (you keep more of your sales revenue)
- Promotion and marketing of your work through all Gallery social media and advertising.
- All work submitted through the Gallery's online portal will appear on the Gallery's website.

If an artist wishes to purchase more than one space, they are more than welcome too, so long as they pay for that space accordingly. (ex. 2 spaces = \$400)

Artists are required to become a member of Bryan Memorial Gallery to have your work shown in this exhibition. If you have been a recent member of Bryan Memorial Gallery, but your membership is not current, or if you have not been a member previously, a Membership form can be found on the Gallery's website:

http://www.bryangallery.org/membership.php. All works must be available for sale.

SPECIFICATIONS:

Only original works conceived and created by the entrant, will be considered. Artwork must be suitably framed, with hanging cable installed on the backs of the paintings. **Sawtooth or clip hangers are not allowed.** Unframed, "gallery wrapped" canvases, with a depth of 1.5" or greater and with the edges painted, are acceptable.

Artists will be **expected to curate and install their own work** with the help of a present staff member.

SCHEDULE:

Monday, January 8: Registration opens.

Sunday, February 4: Online submission opens to registered artists and registration fee of \$200 is due. (See

above)

Sunday, February 25: Online submission to this exhibition must be received at

www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin/ on or before this date.

Monday, March 4 or

Tuesday, March 5: Artists will come in between the Gallery's hours of operation of 10am – 4pm to install

their works.

Wednesday, March 6: Exhibition opens to the public.

Sunday, May 12: Last day of exhibition.

Artists can begin to collect their work Sunday May 12, 2024. Work MUST be collected

from the Gallery no later than Sunday May 26, 2024.

SELECTION PROCESS: This exhibition is an artist curated portion of the show with the subject matter at your

discretion, and as such the Gallery kindly requests artists refrain from submitting portraits. If you do choose to submit any works that is a portrait, you may be asked to withdraw your submission, or be required to submit a permission release. Bryan Memorial Gallery reserves the right to deny any work should it be deemed offensive,

inappropriate, or sexual in nature.

If one or multiple pieces of your work is to sell you may bring in and install a new piece

to replace the missing work.

TAGS: Artists must attach TAGS to the back of the accepted works with their NAME, TITLE OF

WORK, IMAGE DIMENSIONS (height x width: excluding mat and frame.), MEDIUM

AND PRICE. Tags are available at the Gallery's website:

http://bryangallery.org/pdfs/ArtworkTags.pdf. Please have your work labeled in

advance of bringing it into the gallery.

RECEIPT FORM: Titles and prices listed on your submissions to the Gallery's portal cannot be changed

after the work has been accepted. No substitutions will be accepted. When delivering or shipping your work, please include a completed receipt form. The form can be found on

the Gallery's website at http://www.bryangallery.org/pdfs/PaintingReceiptForm.pdf.

DELIVERY: Works must be delivered and installed by the artist by March 4 or 5.

INSURANCE: While the utmost care will be taken in handling all works, Bryan Memorial Gallery does

not assume the responsibility for loss or damage of artwork. All risks of loss or damage

at the institution or in transit will be borne by the artist.

SALES AND

COMMISSIONS: If any of your work being displayed at the Gallery has been sold, 30% of the sale price

will be retained by Bryan Memorial Gallery and 70% of the sale price will be remitted to the artist by check from the Bryan Memorial Gallery. Bryan Memorial Gallery will retain

and remit the sales tax. As a not-for-profit organization, Bryan Memorial Gallery provides the artists with an opportunity to exhibit, but does not assume the role of

agent or representative.

EXHIBITION DATES: Exhibiting artists must agree to leave their works at Bryan Memorial Gallery for the

duration of the exhibition. No exceptions.

UNSOLD PIECES: After the exhibition, any unsold works will be returned to the artist. The artist is

required to personally remove all of their works from the walls. Please note the dates

for pick up as the Gallery is limited in storage space.
