

Art in Bloom May 7 – July 6, 2025

SUBJECT: Artists working in all mediums and styles may submit works that explore

the theme of nature's flora. Artists are encouraged to draw inspiration from flowers, plants, botanical gardens, and floral and to incorporate a

wide range of styles and techniques, from realistic to abstract.

Florists and gardening enthusiasts will be invited to select a piece of their choice from the show to represent with their own floral perspective.

Floral works and paintings will be displayed "side by side" in the exhibit.

SCHEDULE:

Sunday, March 9: Online submissions open.

Sunday, March 30: Submissions including images, documentation must be received at

www.bryangallery.org/artistartistsadmin/ on or before this date, by 6pm.

Sunday, April 13: Artists will be informed of the jurors' decision.

Sunday, April 27: All works for this show must be shipped or delivered to Bryan Gallery.

Works can be delivered in person or shipped to the gallery (at the artist's

expense).

Wednesday, May 7: Exhibition opens to the public.

Sunday, July 6: Last day of exhibition.

Artists can begin to collect their work on Sunday, July 6. Work must be

collected from the gallery no later than Monday July 20, 2025. Please

arrange your pickup with the Gallery at 802-644-5100 or info@bryangallery.org. Out of town artists should provide

arrangements with the gallery for the return shipping of their artwork.

ELIGIBILITY: Up to 3 original works may be submitted. Works must be 2-dimensional.

Exhibiting artists are required to become a member of Bryan Gallery to

have your work exhibited. All works must be available for sale.

SPECIFICATIONS: Artwork must be suitably framed, with hanging cable installed on the

backs of the paintings. Sawtooth or clip hangers are not allowed.

Unframed, "gallery wrapped" canvases, with a depth of 1.5" or greater

and with the edges painted, are acceptable.

HOW TO SUBMIT: There is no fee to enter this exhibit.

All entries must be presented through the gallery's online submissions

process www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin no later than 6pm on

Sunday, March 30, 2025. Non-Gallery members should contact us so that

we can give you access to the online submission form.

Photo Specs: All photos must be properly cropped, with proper lighting; no shadow or frame. Please photograph before framing behind glass to

avoid reflection or glare. iPhone photos are acceptable.

TAGS: Artists must attach TAGS to the back of the accepted works.

Please have your work labeled prior to dropping off at the gallery.

SALES AND

COMMISSIONS: The Bryan Gallery Commission rate is 50/50.

The Bryan Gallery retains 50% of the total sale price for any painting sold,

with the artist receiving the other 50% of the sale of his/her work. The

Gallery remits commission checks to artists via postal mail.

UNSOLD PIECES: All artwork must be removed from the walls on the dates specified.
